Sharon Green loves teaching English Country Dancing. One of her greatest joys is welcoming newcomers to the beauty of English dancing. She called her first dance, Jack's Health, in June 1993. Since then she has travelled and studied extensively, honing her skills as a caller and teacher. Sharon has taught at many festivals and workshops in the US, UK, Canada and Japan. She currently lives in the San Francisco Bay Area and frequently calls dances and balls from Victoria to San Diego. We are delighted to welcome her to Winnipeg.

The Flying Romanos began as the house band for the 'North Jersey English Country Dancers' in 1988 and are now based in the greater New York City area. In the early years of playing together their primary focus was English Country Dance music. Since then they have diversified and now quite happily play music for contras and Scottish country dancing. The members of the group are **Robin Russell** on piano, **Marnen Laibow-Koser** on violin and viola and **Norma Castle** on flute and percussion. The Flying Romanos will be playing for all workshops and dances during the weekend **except** the Sunday evening workshop.

The Village Green English Country Dancers are the sponsors of this weekend workshop.

More than 30 years ago David Williams talked with John Trevenen about organizing a team of dancers to perform in a British Folkways show at Pantages Theatre. The dancers involved loved the dancing so much that they met several times over the next year. The following year the Village Green English Country Dancers and the Village Green Morris Men came into existence as a group.

The Village Green English Country Dancers now have 70 members, 8 teachers and its own house band, The Fine Companions.

This year Village Green and the Mantoba International Folk Dance Association (MIFDA) have joined forces to organize three contra plus evenings. The Friday evening of this workshop is the third of these evenings. Village Green thanks MIFDA for sharing their usual evening of dance with us and for their financial support in covering the hall costs for the Friday dance. We look forward to having them call the last hour of dancing on Friday evening.
